Organizational Information

The Horner Cycling Foundation is a 501C3 non-profit.

The Mission of the Horner Cycling Foundation is to create a junior road cycling team that is inclusive, accessible to all socioeconomic statuses with the focus on skill development, team building and fostering a life-long love of cycling.



We currently have a development team of 10 youth athletes whose ages range from 7-13. This summer they have been training once a week with our coaches and racing the Bend Summer Crit Series that

we put on in July. It's been so fun to see their confidence build socially and, on their bike. Because Chris, like many young athletes, did not grow up with the financial means to support his dream of

becoming a professional cyclist, Chris and HCF want to assure that money is never a barrier to getting kids involved in this lifetime sport. Like Chris, HCF often leans on support from Master's riders and cycling enthusiasts to pay for race entry fees, equipment, housing, and transportation for HCF athletes and participants. HCF will support team members in paying any needed expenses so juniors can focus on enjoying their sport. All necessary equipment and expenses for young athletes will be covered by the Horner Cycling Foundation, and that is why we need supporters like you.





Our vision for HCF is to give back to juniors and to positively benefit the community by producing local racing opportunities,

clinics, and family rides, all at no cost to participants. The past two summers, the HCF put on a 4-week criterium series and a 4-week cyclocross series, which were funded by donations. The local racing community came out and were so enthusiastic. Every crit and cyclocross race had races for kids



starting at three years of age, and we were blown away by the number of young riders who came out each week to participate. Additionally, HCF is collecting donated road and cyclocross bikes from the community to create a "bike library" to loan to riders who need them. www.hornercyclingfoundation.com



General Rules

- Pre-Race Packet pickup will occur at Sagebrush Cycles, 345 SW Century Dr., Ste. 100, Bend, OR 97702. Friday, August 9, from 3:00 p.m.-6:00 p.m.
- Race Day packet pickup will occur 30 minutes prior to the start of each event under the OBRA tent on NW Minnesota between Wall and Bond.
- Race numbers are not transferable.
- OBRA single event memberships waived for all Pro 1/2 Open and Pro 1/2 Women
- OBRA single event memberships required by all non-OBRA members racing in the amateur divisions.
- No refunds will be given.
- One bib number and a bike number will be issued for all the categories.



Miscellaneous Rules

- All racers must queue in the designated staging corral 10 minutes before the start of their race.
- Free lap rule is in effect but ends with a determined number of laps remaining and will be announced at the start line of each race by the Chief Referee for all races.
- All racers are responsible for knowing the course and following OBRA rules.
- Protests and appeals must be made within the time limits established by the OBRA rules.

Bib Numbers

- Each race packet will contain one race number and bike number. Numbers may not be folded or trimmed. You will receive a second number if you are racing in more than one category.
- Numbers must be worn on the right side for all races and the bottom should be aligned with the side seam of the jersey (vertical orientation).



Finishes, Prizes, and Primes

- After finishing, please do not congregate at the finish line.
- Payouts will be in the form of a check. Primes will be in the form of product and/or cash.
- Pro category payouts will happen 30 minutes after their race. Team or rider must submit a W-9 if prize money is \$600 or more.
- YOU MUST SHOW YOUR RACE NUMBER TO CLAIM PRIMES.
- Only the racer can claim primes. The racer must provide a legible signature when claiming primes.
- Primes will be available after each race's results have been made final at the OBRA Registration tent on NW Minnesota.
- Special attention should be paid to the timeliness of protests and appeals.
- If you win over \$600, you must fill out a W-9 form before receiving a payout.
- The Top Three in each category will receive a 32 oz, wide mouth Hydro Flask engraved with the CCC iconic logo!



Awards Protocol

- The top three Pro Cat 1/2 Open and Pro Cat 1/2 Women must wear their full team uniform to each awards presentation. The podiums for each criterium will take place 10 minutes following the finish of the last race, women first followed by the open category.
- All other events will also have a podium ceremony. The top three finishers are to be at the podium 15 minutes following their race. After the next race has started, we will start the podium ceremony. It will be close to the stage.

Neutral Support

Neutral wheels will be provided by Modus Sports/Shimano. However, you may add your own
wheels to the pit. The pit will be located on Franklin Avenue near Lava. Sagebrush Cycles will be
on hand for technical support.

Distance: 1 MILE

Price: July 22nd - August 9th: (or until we sell out).

(NO DAY OF RACE REGISTRATION): \$50,

Youth (18 and under) \$40.

Start Time: ~ 5:45. We'll need to have you staged early and our start time will be approximate based on the nature of fitting it in between bike races.

Packet Pickup: Friday August 9, 3:00-5:30 PM, Day of race bib pick up from 1-5 PM - Please consider getting your packet as early as possible to allow adequate time for staging. Please plan accordingly for downtown traffic, limited parking and getting into downtown as we expect delays due to road closures. Packet Pickup: at FootZone located in Downtown Bend at 842 NW Wall Street.

Where: FootZone 842 NW Wall Street, Bend OR

Pace: Due to our limited time slot in the event schedule ALL racers should be able to complete the mile in 10 minutes or under, unfortunately we cannot accommodate walkers, dogs or strollers in this event.

Course: A circuit in downtown bend, please see the attached map, the event will be 1 mile and require ~ 1.5 laps of the bike racecourse. (slightly altered start location from the bike route with shared finish line on Wall St)





